

PREMIER — COMMISSION OF INQUIRY

9. Hon Martin Aldridge to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer to the government announcement on 15 May 2017 that a commission of inquiry is established to examine 26 projects of the former Government, and ask:

- (a) what is the total projected cost of the inquiry;
- (b) when will the inquiry report;
- (c) what are the terms of reference;
- (d) what is the expected cost directly related to the inquirer Mr John Langoulant AO; and
- (e) how many staff will be engaged by the inquiry?

Hon Sue Ellery replied:

- 1. \$1.5 million
- 2. 15 November 2017
- 3. [See tabled paper no 292.]
- 4. \$220 per hour plus GST over 26 weeks.
- 5. Public sector officers are being provided by agencies to assist the Special Inquirer complete the Inquiry. Costs for these staff will be met from within existing Departmental resources.
