

PERTH AIRPORT — RAILWAY LINE

821. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the proposed airport rail line.

- (1) Will each of the three proposed railway stations have public car parks?
- (2) If yes, how many parking bays are proposed for each station?
- (3) What will be the cost for people to park at each of these railway stations?
- (4) Has the government reached agreement with Perth Airport to provide land for these car parks on airport land?
