

FOREST PRODUCTS COMMISSION — CONTRACTS OF SALE

1014. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Forestry:

Will the Minister please provide a list of all the buyers, other than sawmills, that have contracts of sale with the Forest Products Commission for the purchase of native forest products, and include:

- (a) contract name;
- (b) contract number;
- (c) product (species and grade);
- (d) quantity per annum;
- (e) current expiry date; and
- (f) final expiry date?

Hon Ken Baston replied:

- (a)–(f) The attached table lists all of the buyers, other than sawmills, that have executed contracts of sale with the Forest Products Commission for the purchase of native forest products. The information contained in the table includes contract name, contract number, product (species and grade), quantity per annum and the current and final expiry dates of each contract. The quantity of the products allocated under each contract does not necessarily mean that these customers take their full quota each year [see tabled paper no 1684.].
