*Answer:* Please see the following table.

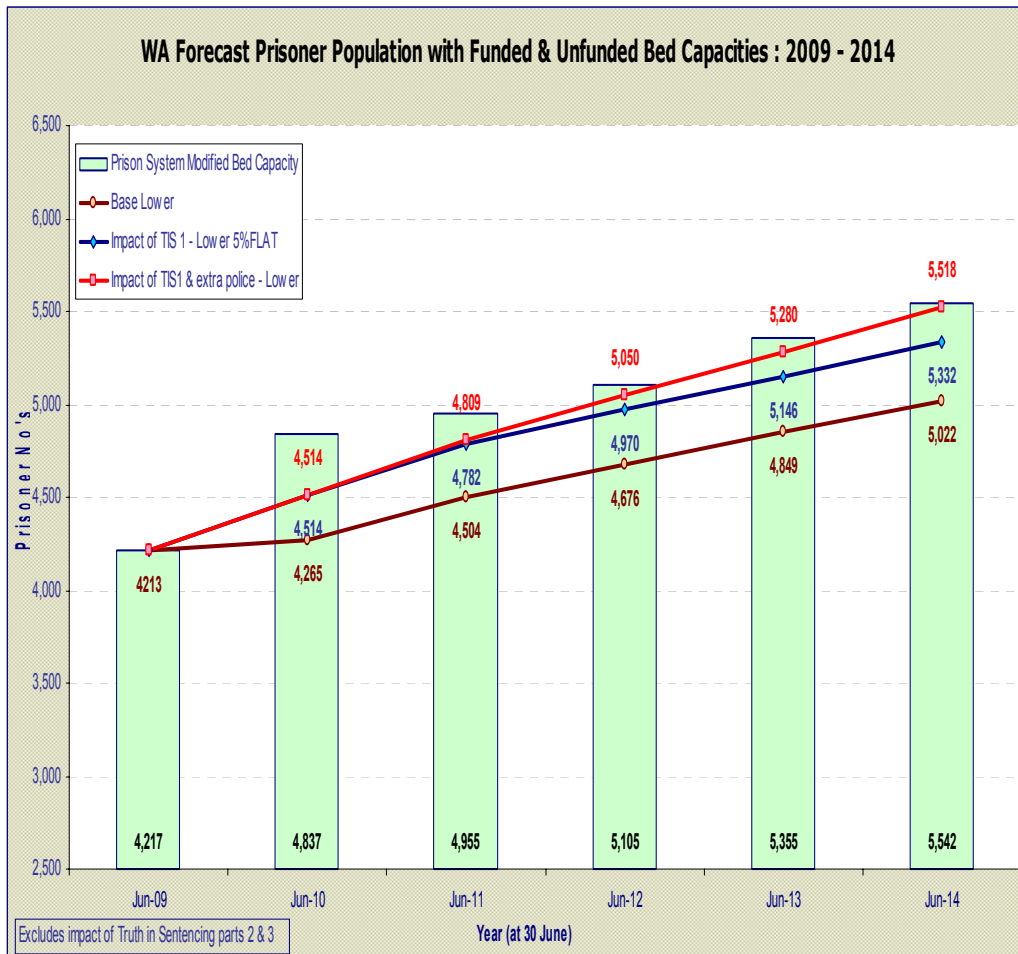

*Question: Mr P. Papalia asked the Minister to provide the diagrammatic representation of the information related to anticipated additional prisoner population by the end of not this financial year, but the end of the next one. Mr Papalia stated that he wanted a reference as to how effective the increased number of beds would be in meeting the new model demand as a result of changes to legislation.*

NOTE: The Prison System Modified Capacity figures excludes 74 beds at Wooroloo (Jun 10 – Jun 14) as these beds are not a component of the Custodial Infrastructure Program (CIP) initiative.

*Question: Ms M.M. Quirk asked the minister to provide details of allegations referred to the Corruption and Crime Commission relating to officers.*

*Answer:* In accordance with Section 28 of the Corruption and Crime Commission Act 2003, all allegations of misconduct by the Department of Corrective Services employees are reported to the Corruption and Crime Commission. From 1 July 2008 to 31 May 2009, 279 allegations were reported.

***[Supplementary Information No B14.]***

*Question: Ms M.M. Quirk asked whether the minister could provide details of how many instances of smuggling by officers have been recorded or how many times have instances of smuggling by officers been detected?*

*Answer:* Of the 8 allegations of smuggling by officers made, 6 were found to be substantiated.
