

TRANSPORT PORTFOLIO — OUTSTANDING DECISIONS

**1253. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the Minister for Transport:**

- (1) For each of the following outstanding issues or election commitments in the transport portfolio, can the minister advise when he expects to make a final decision on —
- (a) which airports will be included in the future regulated regional air service networks to Western Australia;
  - (b) the review of the Perth bicycle network plan;
  - (c) the grain freight rail network review;
  - (d) the return of government-owned taxi plates to the private sector;
  - (e) the upgrade of the Greenbushes railway;
  - (f) the trialling and development of additional peak-period trunk bus routes;
  - (g) the review of the permit system for restricted access vehicles and concessional loading permits; and
  - (h) the review of the school bus contract?
- (2) When does the minister expect to make his decision public on each of these issues?
