

REGIONAL RECREATIONAL BOAT FACILITIES — FUNDING

6113. Hon Adele Farina to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

I refer to the Royalties for Regions — Regional Recreational Boat Facilities' allocation of \$5 million in the 2012–13 Budget, and I ask —

- (1) How much of this funding is being spent in —
 - (a) the city of Bunbury; and
 - (b) the city of Busselton?
- (2) In relation to (1)(a) and (b), what projects/planning work is being undertaken and what funding has been allocated to each?

- (2) Sykes foreshore jetty and washdown bay — replace deteriorated jetty and install a washdown bay — \$347 228.

Port Geographe parking — planning grant to review parking at Port Geographe — \$25 842.
