

PLANNING — RESIDENTIAL DESIGN CODES — AMENDMENT 32

Petition

MRS L.M. HARVEY (Scarborough — Minister for Police) [9.01 am]: I have a petition that conforms to the standing orders and has been signed by 192 petitioners. It reads as follows —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, believe that the amendments to the State Residential Design Codes by the State Government, as approved by the Hon John Day MLA, Minister for Planning, in relation to permitting Multiple Dwellings within a residential R40 zoning within the City of Stirling, are having a negative impact upon residential streets because of their blanket application both in Scarborough and other suburbs throughout the City of Stirling given, but not limited to, the impact on density; population; number of cars; and impact on infrastructure.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to request that the Hon John Day MLA, Minister for Planning, approve Amendment 32, without modification, as supported by the Council of the City of Stirling.
