

INFRASTRUCTURE AUSTRALIA SUBMISSION — PERTH AIRPORT ROAD PROJECTS

1196. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Premier's announcement last week regarding the state government's latest submission to Infrastructure Australia, which included road upgrades around Perth Airport as the government's number one priority.

- (1) Can the minister detail all the road projects surrounding the airport that were included in the state government's submission?
- (2) What is the estimated total cost for each of these projects?
- (3) What is the government's preferred time line for work on each of these projects to commence and to be completed?
- (4) Has any money already been allocated to any of these projects by either the state or federal government; and, if so, how much by each government?
- (5) Has the Perth Airport transport master plan been completed; and, if not, when does the minister expect the plan to be completed?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) A package of required works is currently being developed and will include works on Tonkin Highway, Great Eastern Highway to Roe Highway, Leach Highway-Orrong Road to the airport, and Orrong Road-Great Eastern Highway to Leach Highway.
- (2) The total estimated cost is currently \$600 million.

Hon Ken Travers: Is that for each of the projects?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN: No; that is the total cost.

- (3) It is expected that delivery of various works related to the projects could be over the period 2014 to 2016, depending on the outcome of funding arrangements and negotiations currently under consideration by the state and federal governments.
- (4) There is currently \$19 million allocated in the forward estimates.
- (5) No; it is expected to be completed by mid-2010.
