

SENIOR DRIVER'S LICENCE RENEWAL — MEDICAL ASSESSMENTS

1095. Hon KEN BASTON to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Health:

I refer to the ABC Kimberley report “WA Government faces \$55k payout over medical fee mistakes” regarding people being incorrectly charged for seniors’ driver’s licence medicals.

- (1) Will the WA Country Health Service be proactively contacting people who were mistakenly charged for this service?
- (2) Which WA Country Health Service locations are known to have charged \$280 for this service?
