

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES — TENDER PROCESS OUTSIDE OF PUBLIC SECTOR

1501. Hon Ljiljana Ravlich to the Minister for Transport

For all tenders requested by each Department and Agency within the Minister's portfolios -

- (1) What tender processes were managed by an entity outside of the public sector?
- (2) Of those managed outside of the public sector —
 - (a) who managed the tender process;
 - (b) what was the description of the tender;
 - (c) what was the value of the tender;
 - (d) what fee was paid for the management of the tender process; and
 - (e) who was the tender awarded to?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

Public Transport Authority

- (1) None.

Main Roads

- (1) The Department of Treasury and Finance's Building Management and Works (BMW) business unit is responsible for the establishment and administration of contracts for building maintenance works in Main Roads facilities. BMW has established contracts with private sector facility management companies to assist it in this role. The facility management companies undertake their work in compliance with Government works procurement policies.
- (2) (a)(e) The facilities management companies are involved in the procurement of thousands of works jobs each year, the vast majority of which are below the public tender threshold of \$150 000. The resourcing effort and cost of responding to the details sought on each of these jobs is prohibitive.

Department of Transport
