

BRIAN PONTIFEX — SALARY AND ALLOWANCES

**315. Hon SUE ELLERY to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

I refer to the Premier's chief of staff, Mr Brian Pontifex.

- (1) What is the total value of Mr Pontifex's entire salary package?
- (2) What is the percentage increase he can expect each year?
- (3) What are the additional benefits, such as a car, superannuation and allowances, that Mr Pontifex receives above and beyond his base salary, and what is the individual value of each of these benefits?
- (4) What is the basis of Mr Pontifex's employment, and will the Premier table a copy of his employment contract?
- (5) What additional duties is Mr Pontifex performing above what Mrs Willmott was doing to justify the extra payment?

**Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:**

On behalf of the Leader of the House, I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) \$343 523.
- (2) Increases are aligned to the Salaries and Allowances Tribunal's determination for the special division of the public service.
- (3) His superannuation is \$26 548 and the car is \$22 000.
- (4) Mr Pontifex is employed as a ministerial officer under section 68 of the Public Sector Management Act 1994.
- (5) Mr Pontifex performs the functions as are from time to time specified by the Premier.
