

POINT-TO-POINT SPEED CAMERAS

**186. Hon HELEN BULLOCK to the minister representing the Minister for Road Safety:**

I refer to the Monash University Accident Research Centre 2008 report titled “Development of Strategies for Best Practice in Speed Enforcement in Western Australia”, which included recommendations for the use of point-to-point speed cameras.

- (1) Can the minister confirm that this recommendation is no longer being considered by government?
- (2) If yes to (1), what is the reason for abandoning this expert recommendation?
- (3) If no to (1), when will point-to-point speed cameras be introduced?

**Hon PETER COLLIER replied:**
