

MANGLES BAY MARINA

**1274. Hon LYNN MacLAREN to the minister representing the Minister for Lands:**

I refer to LandCorp's webpage about Mangles Bay marina titled "A place for everyone".

- (1) How many years will it take to complete construction of the proposed Mangles Bay marina?
- (2) By what date is it expected that the 500 new marina pens will be built?
- (3) Of the proposed 500 new pens, how many will be available to members of the public who are not resident within the proposed marina development?
- (4) How many of the existing swing moorings in Mangles Bay will be removed to make way for the marina?
- (5) How many swing moorings currently exist in Mangles Bay?

**Hon COL HOLT replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of the question.

- (1) It is anticipated that the development program will span 10 years from commencement to completion, with the marina water body expected six years after commencement of construction.
- (2) The marina will be delivered on a staged basis. The first stage, which will accommodate up to 350 boats, is to be delivered four years into the development program. The second stage will be delivered over a further two-year period, taking the total capacity of the marina to 500 boats.
- (3) The commercial marina manager will determine the allocation of pens within the marina. The allocation has not yet been determined; however, the majority of the pens will be available to the public.
- (4)–(5) Licensed swing moorings are under the control and management of the Department of Transport.
