- (7) How many juvenile custodial officers were employed at Banksia Hill at this time?
- (8) How many of these juvenile custodial officers were on sick or stress leave at this time?
- (9) How many psychologists were employed at Banksia Hill at this time?
- (10) How many nurses were employed at Banksia Hill at this time?

- (2) 10
- (3) 11 (includes both remand and arrest status).
- (4) 97
- (5) 88 (includes both remand and arrest status).
- (6) 46
- (7) 211
- (8) 6 on sick leave. There is no provision for “stress leave” under the Juvenile Custodial Officers’ Award.
- (9) One on 20 January 2013. There are 21 Psychologists employed to service youth population in custody and community. These resources are centrally located and deployed based on demand for services
