

METRONET — COMMONWEALTH FUNDING

2103. Mrs L.M. Harvey to the Minister for Transport; Planning; Lands:

There is Commonwealth Funding for Metronet and related projects in the budget of \$9 million in 2017–18, \$25 million in 2018–19, \$100 million in 2019–20 and \$658 million in 2020–21, which projects have these Commonwealth funds been allocated to?

Ms R. Saffioti replied:

The allocation of the Commonwealth Funds to METRONET Projects is as follows:

Yanchep Rail Extension – \$344.7 million

Thornlie–Cockburn Link – \$360 million

Rail Line Planning – \$14.7 million

Level Crossing Removal – Denny Avenue – \$49.6 million

Improved Signalling – Planning – \$7.4 million.

The remaining \$15.6 million is the Commonwealth Funding component of the additional \$25 million allocated to the Future Urban Rail Procurement item in PTA’s Asset Investment Program. See page 639 of Budget Paper 2.
