

TRAIN STATIONS — KARNUP STATION

2108. Mrs L.M. Harvey to the Minister for Transport; Planning; Lands:

- (1) What is the current estimate of the cost of the Karnup Station?
- (2) Does the Karnup Station require any land acquisition and if so which entity/entities currently own the land and what is the current valuation of the land to be acquired?
- (3) Have any entities approached the Minister regarding the State acquiring land for the Karnup station and if yes, which entity/entities?
- (4) What is the allocation for planning for this project from the \$54.2 million for 2017–18, 2018–19, 2019–20, 2020–21?
- (5) What is the allocation from the \$47.1 million beyond 2020–21 for this project?
- (6) What is the current population in the catchment of the Karnup Station?
- (7) What are the population projections for the catchment of the Karnup Station?

Ms R. Saffioti replied:

- (1)–(2) \$2 million is allocated in the 2017–18 State Budget to develop the necessary Business Case and Project Definition Report for the proposed Karnup Station. This work will include development of the cost estimate and land acquisition requirements.
- (3) As at 10 October 2017, the Minister’s office has not been approached regarding land acquisition for Karnup station.
- (4)–(5) Refer to answer for parts (1)–(2).
- (6) Approximately 31,000, including Karnup, Secret Harbour, Golden Bay, Singleton, Lakelands and Madora Bay.
- (7) Approximately 60,000 by 2036.
