

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AUTHORITY — GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS —
BRIEFING NOTES

706. Hon Dr STEVE THOMAS to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer to the answer to my question without notice 677 asked yesterday on whether the Premier's office had received the briefing note on the Environmental Protection Authority guidelines proposal on greenhouse gas emissions, and to the story on page 11 of *The West Australian* today by Nick Butterly and Josh Zimmerman, which quotes the Premier's spokesman as saying, "the note was forwarded to a staff member in the Premier's office".

- (1) What is the name of the staff member who received the note on 27 February 2019?
- (2) Who in the Premier's office, the Department of the Premier and Cabinet or the department of state development was forwarded a copy of the note from the original recipient?
- (3) Did the chief of staff of the Premier, Mr Guy Houston, receive a copy of the note; and, if so, on what date?
- (4) Did the director general of the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, Mr Darren Foster, receive a copy of the note; and, if so, on what date?
