

WILSON PARKING — PERSONAL LICENSING INFORMATION

592. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the October 2008 report on the release of personal licensing information to Wilson Parking.

- (1) Can the minister advise which of the 34 recommendations of this report have been implemented partially or in full?
- (2) For each recommendation not implemented in full, can the minister advise why the recommendation has not been implemented?
- (3) Has the Department of Transport addressed confidentiality issues with Wilson Parking to obtain the greatest level of confidence that the information will remain confidential?
- (4) If yes, is the agreement in writing and will the minister table a copy of the agreement?
