Criminal Law Amendment (Home Burglary and Other Offences) Bill — Personal Explanation

MRS L.M. HARVEY (Scarborough — Minister for Police) [2.42 pm]: Under standing order 148, I seek to make a personal explanation.

The SPEAKER: Proceed.

Mrs L.M. HARVEY: I want to make it really clear in my response to the member for Butler's question that when I was talking about the amendments on the notice paper, I was referring to the amendments that we as a government have made not having any substantial effect on the Criminal Law (Mentally Impaired Accused) Act 1996 and the rights of those people who fall under that act, nor on people who fall under section 27 of the Criminal Code. For the benefit of members opposite, the reason that I am in charge of taking the legislation through this house is that I now represent the Attorney General in the Legislative Assembly.
