

LAW REFORM COMMISSION —
“REVIEW OF CORONIAL PRACTICE IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA” — RECOMMENDATIONS

310. Hon Alison Xamon to the Leader of the House representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the 2012 Law Reform Commission report, *Review of Coronial Practice in Western Australia*, and I ask:

- (a) which of the 113 recommendations made by the Law Reform Commission have been acted upon;
- (b) of the recommendations which not been acted upon, which ones are supported by the Government;
- (c) does the Government intend to act upon the recommendations in (b);
- (d) if yes to (c), when; and
- (e) if yes to (c), will recommendations requiring legislative change be addressed through the development of a new Coroners Act or amendment to existing legislation?

Hon Sue Ellery replied:

- (a)–(e) Recommendations 55 and 56 are reflected in the bill currently before the Council and the remainder are under consideration by the Government.
