6195. Hon Alison Xamon to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

I refer to improvements to train stations on the Midland line, and I ask —

- (1) Are there currently any plans to upgrade the Bayswater train station?
- (2) If yes to (1), please provide details of —
 - (a) the work to be undertaken;
 - (b) the estimated cost; and
 - (c) the time-frame in which it is likely this work will occur?
- (3) If no to (1), why not?

 - (a) The upgrade work at Bayswater station is planned to include the following:
 - Car parking
 - Extension of Principal Shared Path (PSP)
 - Pedestrian access from the PSP and car parking areas
 - Improvements to the platform
 - New lighting, communications systems and landscaping.
 - (b) The planned works are subject to tender prices.
 - (c) Subject to availability of funding, construction of the Bayswater station upgrade is planned for the 2013 / 2014 Financial Year.
