

PUBLIC HOUSING — VACANT PROPERTIES — SOUTH METROPOLITAN REGION

1059. Hon KATE DOUST to the Minister for Housing:

I refer to the housing properties in the South Metropolitan Region.

- (1) How many public housing properties are currently vacant in each suburb within the South Metropolitan Region?
- (2) Of those vacant properties, how many are vacant for each of the following reasons —
 - (a) refurbishment or extensive maintenance between tenancies,
 - (b) awaiting occupation by a new tenant,
 - (c) awaiting sale or demolition prior to redevelopment, and
 - (d) allocation to the management of community housing groups?
- (3) How many public housing properties were vacant due to requiring extensive maintenance on 1 September in each of the following years —
 - (a) 2012,
 - (b) 2013, and
 - (c) 2014.
