

TRANSPORT — FREIGHT AND LOGISTICS COUNCIL OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

5170. Mrs L.M. Harvey to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Freight and Logistics Council of Western Australia, and I ask:

- (a) Does the Government provide any resources or funding to the Freight and Logistics Council of Western Australia;
- (b) If yes to (a) what are the resources provided and what is the cost of the resources;
- (c) Does the Minister, Government or the Governor appoint the Chair or any members to the Council;
- (d) If yes to (c) which members have been appointed by the Minister, Government or the Governor;
- (e) Who is responsible for setting the remuneration of the members of the Council and for paying the remuneration; and
- (f) What is the level of remuneration for the Chair?

**Ms R. Saffioti replied:**

- (a) Yes.
- (b) The Department of Transport currently provides \$200,000 in funding per annum to the Freight and Logistics Council of Western Australia. The Executive Officer of the Council is a Main Roads WA employee who is temporarily seconded to the Council, but continues to be paid by Main Roads WA.
- (c)–(d) This information is publicly available on the Freight and Logistics Council of WA website.
- (e) Only the Chair of the Council received remuneration. Members of the Council are not remunerated.
- (f) Of the \$200,000 funding allocation, the Chair is to receive a maximum amount of \$30,000 per annum, plus expenses approved by the Board.
