

EELUP ROUNDABOUT — FLYOVER CONSTRUCTION

**122. Hon ADELE FARINA to the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the Eelup roundabout and the Liberal Party's election commitment to build a flyover.

- (1) How much of the \$15 million allocated towards this project in the 2009–10 budget has been spent to date?
- (2) When will concept designs, which were due to be completed by the end of 2009, be finalised and made public?
- (3) Does the government intend to construct a smaller roundabout rather than proceed with the construction of the flyover?
- (4) If yes to (3), what are the expected start and completion dates for the construction of a smaller roundabout and when will the design plans for the smaller roundabout be released to the public?
- (5) What is the estimated cost of constructing a smaller roundabout and a flyover?

**Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) It is \$8 560.
- (2) Main Roads Western Australia is currently developing a number of concept options to address traffic management issues at this location. When completed, these options will be considered by government. At this time it is not possible to provide a definitive date for the completion of these concept designs.
- (3) A range of options will be considered as outlined in (2).
- (4)–(5) Timing and cost of construction will be dependent upon which option is chosen.
