

PLANT AND ANIMAL TAXA — THREATENED LISTING

1231. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

- (1) For each of the last 10 calendar years, how many plant and animal taxa have been determined by the Threatened Species Scientific Advisory Committee to require a listing of ‘threatened’ under the *Wildlife Conservation Act 1950*?
- (2) Over the same time period, how many of these recommendations for individual species have been transmitted to the Minister for Environment recommending a ‘threatened’ listing?
- (3) Over the same time period, how many individual species have been approved by the Minister for gazettal as ‘threatened’?

2004 — 15
2005 — 12
2006 — 11
2007 — 16
2008 — 3
2009 — 6
2010 — 10
2011 — 29
2012 — 24
2013 — 10
