

EDUCATION CENTRAL POLICY — HEALTH IMPACT ASSESSMENT

**82. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the Minister for Education and Training:**

Madam President, I also add my congratulations on your appointment as President, and as the first female President in this Parliament.

I refer to the government's Education Central policy, which includes the proposed relocation of the academic select school, currently at Perth Modern School, to a high-rise, inner-city school.

- (1) Has the government commissioned a health impact assessment for this proposal?
- (2) If yes to (1), who is undertaking the assessment and will it involve community consultation; and, if not, why not?
- (3) If no to (1), why not?

**Hon SUE ELLERY replied:**

I thank the member for the question.

- (1)–(3) As I have answered in previous questions, the government is working through all the issues associated with our election commitment about how we address the issues created by the poor planning of the previous government in population growth, particularly on the city side of the western suburbs. When we are ready to make the announcement about all the elements that make up that decision, we will so do.
