

TRANSPORT — PROHIBITION ORDER WARNING NOTICE

3051. Hon Ken Travers to the minister representing the Minister for Transport
- (1) Have any of the 124 people issued with a Prohibition Order Warning Notice committed a further offence outside the legislated timeframes for a Prohibition Order to be applied?
  - (2) If yes to (1) —
    - (a) how many;
    - (b) how much beyond the timeframe was the second or third offence committed; and
    - (c) what offences were involved?
  - (3) What offences were the 124 warning notices issued for?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

- (1) The Public Transport Authority does not maintain records for persons who have committed another prescribed offence out of the periods nominated in the Act which would require a Prohibition Notice to be issued. Each subsequent offence is treated as a new matter and the time periods are reapplied for the date of any new offence.
