

WA LABOR PARTY LOGO — ADVERTISEMENT

**1253. Hon MARTIN ALDRIDGE to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

I refer to tabled paper 2239 that identifies what appears to be a WA Labor advertisement on a Community Newspapers Group website.

- (1) Is the Premier aware of, or has he authorised in any way, the advertisement?
- (2) Has the Department of the Premier and Cabinet played any role in the development of the graphic, with or without the WA Labor logo?
- (3) Is the Premier aware that the WA Labor Party advertisement directs viewers to a Department of the Premier and Cabinet website?
- (4) Will the Premier immediately instruct his party to remove such an advertisement and ensure that the public service is not compromised by this extraordinary political intervention?

- (2)–(4) The online advertisement incorporated into the design elements of a similar advertisement prepared by the Department of the Premier and Cabinet.
