

FORESTRY — 2013–14 LOGGING

2209. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Forestry:

- (1) For the year 2013–2014, regarding thinning of regrowth karri, what volume of extracted logs was:
 - (a) karri; and
 - (b) other (please specify)?
- (2) How much of the volume in (1) was:
 - (a) high quality, first and second grade karri sawlogs;
 - (b) bole karri sawlogs;
 - (c) other karri sawlogs;
 - (d) karri chiplogs;
 - (e) high quality, first and second grade marri sawlogs;
 - (f) other marri sawlogs;
 - (g) marri chiplogs; and
 - (h) other (please specify)?

Silvicultural records of areas thinned are maintained on a calendar (rather than financial) year basis to align with reporting requirements under the respective Forest Management Plans. Information for the 2014 calendar year is still being compiled.

 - (a) In 2013 49,916m³ were karri logs.
 - (b) In 2013 8,163m³ of mixed marri and karri chiplogs.

 - (a) 1,597m³
 - (b)–(c) Nil
- (d) 48,319m³, plus a part of the quantity in question (g–h).
- (e)–(f) Nil
- (g)–(h) 8,163m³, less an unknown portion of karri.
