Petition

MR C.J. TALLENTIRE (Gosnells) [12.01 pm]: I have a petition regarding the much-needed upgrade to Thornlie Senior High School. It reads —

TO THE HONOURABLE THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY
OF THE PARLIAMENT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED.

We, the undersigned, say

The decision to exclude Thornlie Senior High School from the list of schools to be expanded prior to 2015 when Year 7 students start at secondary is unfair and discriminatory.

Now we ask that the Legislative Assembly call upon the State Government to reconsider and to provide Thornlie Senior High School with the infrastructure funding to be able to accommodate Year 7 students with classrooms and specialist facilities so that it can remain a school of choice for parents and students in the South-East Metropolitan suburbs.

The petition has been certified to confirm with the standing orders of the house, and it contains 93 signatures.
