

SECRET HARBOUR POLICE STATION

Petition

MR P. PAPALIA (Warnbro) [12.01 pm]: I have a petition signed by 794 people and certified as complying with standing orders. It reads as follows —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly in the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned say:

Keep the Secret Harbour Police Station

Plans for a new Police Station at Secret Harbour have been put on hold by the Barnett Government. This is despite the land being purchased and funds being made available by the previous State Labor Government.

A Police Station at Secret Harbour is required as a matter of urgency and requires its own dedicated police officers — not officers removed from Rockingham Police Station.

Now we ask that the Legislative Assembly:

Call for the Barnett Government to take immediate steps to progress the construction of the Secret Harbour Police Station and not to remove officers from Rockingham Police Station to staff it.
