

LOCAL PROJECTS, LOCAL JOBS — RESIDUAL AMOUNT

105. Hon TJORN SIBMA to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer to the government's claim, in response to question without notice 68, that projects funded via the Local Projects, Local Jobs grants program are managed by agencies —

... in accordance with existing grant delivery processes and procedures, which include reporting and acquittal requirements.

- (1) Will the government table the business case, grant provided, grant spent, specific purpose of the grant, project evaluation report, and acquittal documentation regarding public funds provided to each of the following four groups —
 - (a) Herb Graham Recreation Centre;
 - (b) Coogee Beach Surf Life Saving Club;
 - (c) Melville Lakers Netball Club; and
 - (d) Karratha Touch Association?
- (2) If not, why not?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)–(2) The Department of the Premier and Cabinet maintains records for projects administered by this department. The information the member has sought is held by the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries and the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development. I suggest the member direct his question to those ministers.
