

BUSINESS OF THE HOUSE

Motion

HON SUE ELLERY (South Metropolitan — Leader of the House) [5.58 pm] — without notice: I move —

- (a) That the house do sit beyond 6.20 pm; and
- (b) that members' statements be taken no later than 9.45 pm.

By way of advice to the house, we are close to completing the passage of the Public Health Amendment (Immunisation Requirements for Enrolment) Bill 2019. I understand that an agreement has been reached across the house that we can finish this bill in a timely fashion—maybe in another 10 or 15 minutes. If that is the case, I also have been given an undertaking that there is an expectation that we will complete the passage of the Local Government Legislation Amendment Bill 2019 tomorrow and deal with the Bail Amendment (Persons Linked to Terrorism) Bill 2018 tomorrow. Therefore, I have accepted the commitments that have been given to me about doing those two things. On that basis, I would seek to sit for only another 15 minutes or so to finish this bill and to then go immediately to members' statements. We would then meet again at 9.00 am for the purpose of dealing with those other two pieces of legislation that I have referred to.
