2139. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Transport

- (1) Is the Government considering privatising —
 - (a) motor vehicle examinations; or
 - (b) motor vehicle license examinations?
- (2) If yes to (1)(a-b), does the Government intend to produce a public-private comparator?
- (3) If no to (1), why not?
- (4) Does the Government believe privatising these areas will lead to savings of Government expenditure?
- (5) If yes to (4), what is the estimated annual savings for Government?
- (6) Does the Government believe privatising these areas will lead to savings for consumers?
- (7) If yes to (6), what is the estimated saving for the consumer?
- (8) What benefits does the Government expect from privatising these services?
- (9) What risks has the Government identified if these services are privatised
