

POLICE — FAMILY AND DOMESTIC VIOLENCE — SHIRE OF MURRAY

5907. Mr D.A. Templeman to the Minister for Police:

I refer to family and domestic violence incidents in the Shire of Murray (Allambee), and surrounds, in each of the years 2014–2015, and 2015–2016, and ask:

- (a) in each of the years 2014–2015 and 2015–2016, how many domestic violence incident reports (DVIR) were recorded in the Shire of Murray;
- (b) in each of the years 2014–2015 and 2015–2016, how many domestic assaults were recorded in the Shire of Murray; and
- (c) in each of the years 2014–2015 and 2015–2016, how many family and domestic violence incidents were attended by police in the Shire of Murray, Waroona, Boddington, and Serpentine–Jarrahdale?

- (a) Data is for General and Crime Domestic Violence Incident Reports (DVIR) created in the Shire of Murray between 01 July 2014 and 30 June 2016.
  - (b) Data is for all Domestic Assault offences reported in the Shire of Murray between 01 July 2014 and 30 June 2016. Note that a given incident report may have multiple domestic assault offences recorded.
  - (c) Data is for all CAD incidents created 01 July 2014 to 30 June 2016 where the job description was recorded as “Domestic (Serious to Minor)” and attendance confirmed (Y) in localities identified as being in the above named shires.
  - (d) General DVIR – incidents where no offence was identified.

A family/domestic relationship is defined by WA Police as including:

Intimate partners; two persons who:

Are or have been in a relationship with each other which has some degree of stability and continuity. It must reasonably be supposed to have, or have had a sexual aspect to the relationship. The partners do not have to be living together on a full time continuing basis and need not ever have done so; or

Immediate family members; two persons who are related whether directly, in-laws or step family, and can involve:

- (i) Parent;
- (ii) Grandparent;
- (iii) One of the persons being a child who ordinarily resides, resided or regularly stays with the other person;
- (iv) Guardian of an involved child.
