**861. Hon PETER COLLIER to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:**

I refer the Premier to the comments of the Commissioner of the Corruption and Crime Commission on page 99 of the fifty-fifth report of the Standing Committee on Procedure and Privileges where he stated —

Our information technology analysts have been informed that the current data from which these tapes will be extracted is likely to be between 400–600 terabytes of data. A further s 95 notice is likely to be issued in the future requiring material from the back up tapes to be produced to the commission.

- (1) Apart from the documents of the former members that were provided to the commission, have any documents of current sitting members been provided to the commission?
- (2) If yes, what documents have been provided and what sitting members?
