

SCHOOLS — ABORIGINAL AND ISLANDER EDUCATION OFFICERS

1209. Hon Alison Xamon to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to additional Aboriginal and Islander Education Officers (AIEOs) funded by the Government, and I ask:

- (a) for each school which has been allocated additional AIEOs, will the Minister please advise:
 - (i) the location of the school; and
 - (ii) how many additional AIEO FTE the school has been allocated;
- (b) are all of these positions based in classrooms;
- (c) if no to (b), please advise where these positions are located; and
- (d) do any of these positions undertake:
 - (i) work outside the classroom to support students' attendance at school; and
 - (ii) community liaison?
