

CASTLETOWN PRIMARY SCHOOL

688. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to Castletown Primary School in Esperance. Since the 2013 building condition assessment report on the school was finalised —

- (a) what is the total amount of funding that has been provided to the school for repairs and maintenance; and
- (b) what repair and maintenance works have been undertaken through the funding referred to in (a) and what was the date of completion for each maintenance project listed?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (a) Since the 2013 building condition assessment report was finalised, \$370 000 has been spent on repairs and maintenance at the school by the Department of Education. Works are also currently underway. At the completion of the works, the total amount of \$550 000 will have been spent on repairs and maintenance at Castletown Primary School funded by the Department of Education. This excludes works paid for by the school.
- (b) I table a spreadsheet of all works undertaken. The Department of Education and the Department of Finance's Building Management and Works have worked extensively with the principal to minimise operational impact by scheduling work when feasible on weekends or in the school holidays, and minimising the number of student relocations during remediation works. All works have been agreed to by the principal.
