*Question:* Mr P.J. Rundle asked for figures on the number of appointments and resignations in the agency in the last financial year.

*Answer:* 228 people have been appointed by the agency between 1 July 2021 and 25 May 2022.

A total 201 people have exited from the agency between 1 July 2021 and 25 May 2022.

The agency's separation rate as at 31 December 2021 was 11.4% compared to the overall public sector separation rate of 9.3% as at 31 December 2021. DLGSC exits tend to be higher as a result of a relatively large portion of the workforce being casual staff based at Sport and Recreation camps. These camps seasonally lose staff at the end of each calendar year as university students graduate and take on full time employment.
