

TRANSPORT — FORRESTFIELD AIRPORT LINK

593. Mrs L.M. Harvey to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Forrestfield Airport Link project and ask:

- (a) Is there an underspend and contingency for this project;
- (b) If yes to (a), what is the total amount;
- (c) Has any of the underspend or contingency been allocated to other projects;
- (d) If yes to provide the project name and amount;
- (e) Is the State Government or the Department of Transport planning on allocating any of the underspend or contingency to any other projects; and
- (f) If yes to (e) provide the project name and amount?

**Ms R. Saffioti replied:**

- (a) Whilst appropriate contingencies are built into every infrastructure project in accordance with Treasury guidelines and costing frameworks the project is not complete and the total cost has not been finalised to determine if an underspend will occur or how much it will be.
