

CONTAMINATED SITES COMMITTEE

1927. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

With regard to the Office of the Contaminated Sites Committee, I ask:

- (a) what is the level of remuneration paid to the Chairman and is the position fulltime;
- (b) what level of remuneration is paid to board members;
- (c) since 1 July 2012 how many times have senior staff travelled for business purposes, to where and at what cost;
- (d) has any member of the Committee travelled on Committee business this financial year, and if so, who, to where, for what purpose and at what cost; and
- (e) has the Minister met with the Committee, and/or its Chairperson, and when and for what purpose?

**Mr A.P. Jacob replied:**

- (a) The Chairperson is paid \$69 822 per annum. The position is part-time (approximately two days per week, as required).
- (b) Members of the Contaminated Sites Committee are paid \$714 per meeting.
- (c) Nil.
- (d) No.
- (e) Yes, the Minister for Environment, Hon Albert Jacob MLA, has met with the Chairperson twice. The Minister has not yet met with the Members, but intends to do so.
