2941. Mr Z.R.F. Kirkup to the minister representing the Minister for Education and Training:

Has any Department, Agency, Government Trading Enterprise or Board within the Minister's portfolio engaged the consulting company Lucid Economics since 1 January 2017, and if so:

- (a) why was Lucid Economics engaged;
- (b) on what date(s) was Lucid Economics engaged; and
- (c) what was the total cost associated with the engagement of Lucid Economics since 1 January 2017?

The answers to these questions encompass Department of Education (Central and Regional Education Offices only). To answer this question for schools would require a survey to be completed by all schools. This has not been undertaken.

The answers to these questions are for Department of Education, Department of Education Services, School Curriculum and Standards Authority and Country High School and Hostels Authority which were merged as part of the machinery of government changes from 1 July 2017. The requested date is prior to this amalgamation.
