

PUBLIC SCHOOLS — FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS

4148. Hon Sue Ellery to the Minister for Education:

For the 2016 school year in all Western Australian public schools, what is the number of FTE for:

- (a) Education Assistants;
- (b) Registrars;
- (c) Cleaners;
- (d) Gardeners; and
- (e) any other non-teaching staff?

Hon Peter Collier replied:

Principals now have increased autonomy regarding how they spend their schools' one-line budgets and how many staff they employ. 2016 calendar year FTE levels will fluctuate from pay period to pay period. In particular, FTE levels are higher during term and lower during vacation.

As at 16 June 2016, paid FTE levels in schools were:

- (a) Education Assistants – 7,614
- (b) Registrars (now titled Managers Corporate Services) – 807
- (c) Cleaners – 1,904
- (d) Gardeners – 607
- (e) any other non-teaching staff (excluding Managers Corporate Services) – 3,072

All other non-teaching staff includes school officers, administrative and clerical staff in schools.
