

HOUSING — DISRUPTIVE MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

1328. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Housing:
- (1) Since the commencement of the disruptive management strategy, how many evictions were from the following property types:
 - (a) one bedroom;
 - (b) two bedroom;
 - (c) three bedroom;
 - (d) four bedroom; and
 - (e) five bedroom?
 - (2) Since the commencement of the disruptive management strategy, how many tenants had been subject to a mandatory referral to the Department for Child Protection and Family Support before eviction?
 - (3) Since the commencement of the disruptive management strategy, how many tenants evicted were subsequently rehoused in state housing?
