

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES — EMPLOYEES —
REDEPLOYEES, SURPLUS OR UNATTACHED

2779. Hon Kate Doust to the Minister for Fisheries:

With reference to all departments and agencies under the Minister's jurisdiction, as well as the *Public Sector Management (Redeployment and Redundancy) Regulations 2014* and the case management of those deemed redeployees, surplus or unattached, can the Minister please advise:

- (a) the actual number of employees who are or will be actively undertaking the role of case management by:
 - (i) position title/description; and
 - (ii) location;
- (b) the actual number of employees who are internal redeployees, surplus or unattached, by:
 - (i) location;
 - (ii) age;
 - (iii) gender;
 - (iv) disability; and
 - (v) Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander identity; and
- (c) what sourcing and funding arrangements are in place for the retraining of those employees who are internal redeployees, surplus or unattached?
