For all departments and agencies in your portfolio, I ask:

- (e) of the total number of vehicles, how many are:
 - (i) petrol;
 - (ii) diesel;
 - (iii) LPG;
 - (iv) LPG/petrol;
 - (v) hybrid petrol/electric;
 - (vi) electric; and
 - (vii) powered by other means;
- (f) for each department or agency, what is the estimated total cost for motor vehicles in 2013-14; and
- (g) how much of the amount in (f) is:
 - (i) capital cost; and
 - (ii) recurrent cost?
