

PERTH MAJOR SPORTS STADIUM — TRANSPORT REQUIREMENTS

5273. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport

In relation to the Burswood Stadium Project, I refer to the recently announced revised figure of 35,500 people travelling to and from events at the stadium, and ask —

- (1) How was the new figure of 35,500 people determined?
- (2) How many trains would be required?
- (3) What modelling was undertaken to ensure the 35,500 people can be achieved?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

The Public Transport Authority advises:

- (1)–(3) A Master Plan, will be completed in the first half of 2013. It will include the provisions and cost estimates for road, rail, bus facilities and the pedestrian bridge.

It is assumed the information referred to by the Member relates to statements made in the Legislative Assembly on 22 Feb 2012. The statement was made on advice from the Public Transport Authority and only planned passenger numbers were advised. A Master Plan for this service is being developed and specific information will be made public as appropriate once it has been considered.
