

FITZROY CROSSING - LIQUOR RESTRICTIONS

1051. Hon KEN BASTON to the Minister for Racing and Gaming:

I refer to the Fitzroy Crossing restrictions on the sale of packaged liquor with an alcohol content greater than 2.7 per cent.

- (1) Does this restriction prohibit members of the Fitzroy community and general travellers from bringing this liquor into the town?
- (2)
 - (a) If yes to (1), how will this be monitored?
 - (b) If no to (1), how will the resale of this prohibited liquor by these people be prevented?

Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The restrictions imposed by the Director of Liquor Licensing apply only to the licensee of the Crossing Inn.
- (2)
 - (a) Not applicable.
 - (b) By the police service enforcing section 109 of the Liquor Control Act 1988, which precludes the sale of liquor by any person who is not the holder of a licence or permit.
