887. Hon DONNA FARAGHER to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to the answer given to question without notice 864 asked yesterday regarding Woodbridge Primary School.

- (1) With regard to the two alternative options to amend the local intake areas, will the minister table the preferred option presented to the affected schools?
- (2) When is the work to amend the local intake areas expected to be completed?
- (3) What is the current student accommodation capacity at Woodbridge Primary School, Guildford Primary School and Midvale Primary School?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) No. For the information of the honourable member, it is a longstanding and standard practice that draft local intake areas are not circulated publicly. The final version is circulated, so I would be concerned if anyone is circulating the draft ones.

Hon Donna Faragher: I am just responding to the question the minister answered yesterday.

Hon SUE ELLERY: Sure. However, the Department of Education can provide a briefing for the honourable member on the process undertaken to develop the local intake area.

- (2) Discussions are continuing with the principals of the affected schools. The work is expected to be completed by the end of September 2019.
- (3) The student accommodation capacity at Woodbridge Primary School is 430; at Guildford Primary School, 340, including the off-site kindergarten; and at Midvale Primary School, 480.
