

TRAINING AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT — VET FEE-HELP — ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

3873. Mr F.M. Logan to the Minister for Training and Workforce Development:

In 2014, what proportion of students was enrolled in courses that were eligible to receive VET FEE-HELP assistance from the commonwealth?

Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:

The VET FEE-HELP program covers all Diploma level and above qualifications and the following Certificate IV level qualifications:

Certificate IV in Aged Care (CHC40108 and any subsequent iterations);

Certificate IV in Disability (CHC40312 and any subsequent iterations);

Certificate IV in Community Services Work (CHC40708 and any subsequent iterations);

Certificate IV in Youth Work (CHC41808, CHC41812, CHC40413) and any subsequent iterations);
and

Certificate IV in Education Support (CHC41708, CHC41712, CHC40213 and any subsequent iterations).

In 2014, 13.7 per cent of publicly funded students were enrolled in these courses.

Note The term 'publicly funded' refers to all training funded by or through the Department of Training and Workforce Development.
